Re: Letter of Permission (LOP), Temporary Placement of Power Cable, Tybee Island, Lazaretto, Chatham County, Georgia

Dear Mr. Hammargren:

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request, dated June 23, 2017, to temporarily run a power cable in the State's Coastal Marshland Protection Act Jurisdiction. This project involves the installation of a supported power cable in a specific designated area. The project will begin no sooner than 15 days after the date on this letter and be completed no later the July 16, 2017.

As proposed, the project scope includes a supported power cable that will be run as diagrammed in red on the attached map. A power cable from the power plant generator parked on the existing access road will supply energy to power lights which will be set up on the upland area to the north of the access road, for the purpose of filming a scene on that upland area. The cable will be suspended over the marsh between these locations by stands placed on the upland at either end so as to prevent any discharge or damage to the marsh. To ensure public safety, pink flagging tape will be secured at regular intervals along the length of the power cables.

No more than 2 crew electricians will install the cable and supports in the marsh. No additional foot traffic or movement of equipment is authorized along this route. All production crew and equipment will be moved along the upland route marked in blue on the attached map.

The Department authorizes the temporary placement of the power cable, as illustrated in the attached project location site plan. This LOP is not meant to exempt the above referenced activity from future environmental laws.

No equipment, materials, or debris may be placed, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas. Any incidental impacts associated with this project must be rectified by fully restoring areas to their pre-construction topographic and vegetative states.

This LOP is valid for the above referenced project. Any change in the use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without prior notification and approval from this office, could result in the revocation of this permission and in the required removal of the materials and related structures. This project must comply with all other Federal, State, and local statutes, ordinances and regulations.
