Re: Letter of Permission (LOP), Soil Boring Sampling, Sea Island Beach Club, Sea Island, Atlantic Ocean, Glynn County, Georgia GPS: (31.179168°N/81.347598°W)

Dear Mr. Mason:

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request, received June 27, 2017, to conduct soil boring sampling on the lawn area within Shore Protection Act (SPA) jurisdiction at the Sea Island Beach Club.

The proposed project includes soil boring sampling on the Sea Island Beach Club lawn in the area indicated on Exhibit A in the enclosed attachment. The soil bore will be 80ft. in depth and 4 in. in diameter. The equipment to be used includes an ATV skidder with a mounted drill as shown in Exhibit C in the enclosed attachment. Due to the size of the equipment, transportation will occur via the existing DNR approved vehicular access route. The mobilization, drilling, and equipment removal will take approximately two (2) days to complete and will be done between 9AM-4PM. This project will take place in the month of July 2017. No dunes or dune vegetation will be disturbed during the mobilization of the equipment. This project will begin no sooner than 15 days from the date of this letter and must be completed by July 31, 2017.

The Department authorizes the soil boring sampling and equipment mobilization as depicted in the attached description and drawings and has no objection to the action, provided Best Management Practices (BMP's) are used. No unauthorized equipment, materials, or debris may be placed, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas. Any incidental damage to dunes or dune vegetation will require restoration to be coordinated through this office. This LOP is valid for the above referenced project. Any change in the use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without prior notification and approval from this office could result in the revocation of this permission and in the required removal of the related structures.

Because the project will occur between May 1st and October 31st, turtle nesting season, an individual with a DNR Sea Turtle Cooperators Permit must survey the area and the access to be used by the equipment prior to the work beginning. All sea turtle nests must be avoided and no heavy equipment may be used within 20ft. of a nest area.


On behalf of Sea Island Acquisition, I respectfully request a Letter of Permission for the following activities at the Sea Island Beach Club:

- Access for construction equipment within the SPA jurisdiction (See Exhibit A)
 along the existing DNR approved access route as illustrated on Exhibit B for the
 following activities:
 - 1 Soil Boring sampling on the Beach Club lawn in the area indicated on Exhibit A.
 - o Equipment Used: ATV Skidder with Mounted Drill
 - o Width of Hole: 4" Diameter
 - o Depth of Hole: 80'
- We anticipate mobilization, drilling and removal of equipment during July 13-20 from 9 AM 4 PM.
- The equipment used includes an ATV skidder with mounted drilling equipment (See Exhibit C) and will all be operated by licensed contractors hired by Sea Island Acquisitions.
