Dear Ms. Garland:

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request, dated October 5, 2017, to replace pilings at the existing dock facility located at 101 Emerald Princess Drive near the Sidney Lanier Bridge in Brunswick, Georgia.

According to the request, there are existing pilings in need of replacement. The work scope includes replacement of approximately all pilings of the existing dock facility. Equipment needed to complete work includes the use of barges and cranes. There will be no changes to the current footprint of this previously permitted dock facility. The project will begin no sooner than 15 days from the date of this letter and be completed within six (6) months from the date of this letter.

The Department authorizes the piling replacement as depicted in the attached description and images, provided all Best Management Practices (BMPs) are used. No unauthorized equipment, materials, or debris may be placed, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas. Any incidental damage to the marsh area or marsh vegetation will require restoration to be coordinated through this office.

Please find enclosed the previous LOP, issued on March 21, 2017, which includes a fully executed Revocable License (RL). This Revocable License serves as authorization to utilize state owned tidal water bottoms for your project. Any change in the use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without prior notification and approval from this office could result on the revocation of this permission and in the required removal of the related structures.


Thank you for your assistance in this matter. We are requesting an extension to the previous LOP dated April 13, 2017 and additional pilings post Hurricane Irma.



Thank you for the provided information. In order to finish processing your request, there are a few things that need some clarification. This is so that your request can be processed accurately and that our files have all the needed information. Items that are needed are as follow:

- 1. The Department needs a potential timeline. This can either consist of a month that the maintenance could occur during or just a potential start and end date.
- Also, is the current plan to replace pilings or add additional pilings? Based on review of the submitted
 drawing, it is unclear if you are adding pilings in new locations or are maintaining those already in existence.
 A new drawing with specific details would help in our understanding of exactly what the plans for the dock
 are.
- 3. The dimensions of the pilings to be used are also needed.

with your approval, we anticipate starting within the next month.


