Describe the proposed activity (attach additional sheets as needed):

The proposed project is the second phase of drainage improvements within the Village Community (Village) and is located along Georgia Street, St. Simons Island in Glynn County, Georgia. Georgia Street is a residential street with public beach access. The proposed project includes replacement of the existing Georgia Street Outfall (12" Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) pipe) with adequate infrastructure to convey stormwater from the Village into the St. Simons Sound. The project will begin at the Georgia Street Outfall heading north to the intersection of Butler, at which, it will turn east heading toward Mallory Lane, and will connect to an existing drop inlet adjacent to an existing retention pond. Adequate infrastructure includes approximately 491 linear feet (LF) of 48" ADS HP Storm Pipe having a custom 7' x 8' cast-in-place concrete headwall with a 48" Tideflex check valve (or similar device), 312 LF of 30" ADS HP Storm Pipe, 11 LF of 24" ADS HP Storm Pipe, 240 LF of 24" x 38" Reinforced Concrete Elliptical Pipe (RCEP), and 4 pre-cast concrete GDOT standard drop inlets. Each proposed drop inlet will have a sump 1 vertical foot below the invert of the entering/exiting pipes, which will act as a water quality filter for undesirable materials to settle in the structure before reaching the St. Simons Sound.

Statement: I have made inquiry to the appropriate authorities that the proposed project is not over landfill or hazardous waste site and that the site is otherwise suitable for the proposed project.
