Re: Letter of Permission (LOP), West Community Dock Maintenance, Sapelo Island, McIntosh County GPS: (31.43488°N/81.28067°W)

Dear Mr. Hay:

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request, dated July 31, 2017, to perform maintenance to the existing west community dock on Sapelo Island.

According to the request, the project involves replacing caps, replacing two (2) wooden pilings on the seaward most end of the walkway, and re-bolting some existing caps. The maintenance area is depicted on the attached drawings. This dock maintenance will remain in and not increase the existing footprint of the structure. A barge will be used to lift the deck and ramp while the dock maintenance is done. The project will begin no sooner than 15 days from the date of this letter and must be completed within six (6) months from the date of this letter.

The Department authorizes the dock maintenance as depicted in the attached description and drawings, provided all Best Management Practices (BMPs) are used. No unauthorized equipment, materials or debris may be placed, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas.

Please find enclosed a fully executed Revocable License (RL) for the project described above. This license serves as authorization to utilize state owned tidal water bottoms for your project. Any change in the use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without prior notification and approval from this office could result on the revocation of this permission and in the required removal of the related structures.

It was nice speaking with you over the phone yesterday afternoon. After our discussion, I pulled our historical files for this site. The only document on file is a Public Notice from the Army Corps of Engineers, from January 26, 1972. This Public Notice contains drawings of the proposed dock. However, these dock drawings are in a different configuration than the current dock. Do you have any files on record from the Department in the past for this dock facility for its current configuration? If not, please provide a drawing of the current configuration and dimensions to better supplement our records. In addition to an updated drawing of the current structure, please provide the following:

- Photographs identifying the pilings to be replaced;
  - o This can be an aerial image with the work area and pilings marked.
- Description including the approximate number of pilings to be replace as well as the caps.
- Signed Revocable License (attached for you convenience).


