Re: Letter of Permission (LOP), Maintenance to Three (3) Drainage Pipes, St. Simons Waterfront LLC, 29 Waterfront Drive, St. Simons Island, Frederica River, Glynn County, Georgia

Dear Mr. Barnard:

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request, dated November 15, 2018, for authorization to maintain three (3) existing drainage pipes located at St. Simons Waterfront LLC in Glynn County, Georgia. According to the request, the drainage pipes will be cleaned using high pressure water and televised. The project will also include the use of an excavator, which must be operated from the upland. The effluent from the pipes during cleaning will be blocked by the excavator bucket and/or plywood to prevent erosion of marsh sediments and vegetation. The debris at the end of the pipes will be removed with a 2ft. excavator bucket and wheelbarrow and disposed of at an offsite location. The project will start no sooner than 15 days from the date of this letter and must be completed within six (6) months.

The Department authorizes the drainage pipe maintenance as depicted in the attached description. Best Management Practices (BMPs) should be used to prevent any erosion and sedimentation at the site and to protect Coastal Marshlands. During maintenance, no unauthorized equipment, materials, or debris may be placed in, disposed of, or stored in marsh jurisdictional areas. Any incidental impacts associated with this project must be rectified by fully restoring areas to their pre-construction topographic and vegetative states.

This LOP is valid for the above referenced project. Any change in the use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without prior notification and approval from this office could result in revocation of this permission and in the required removal of the related structures. This project must comply with all other Federal, State, and local statutes, ordinances and regulations. If you have any questions, you may contact Sam LaBarba at (912) 262-3127.

Upon completion of televising and cleaning of the storm pipes, Southeast Pipe Survey, Inc. will remove on 2' bucket full of debris from end of storm drain, upon written approval from the DNR (Department of Natural Resources). The bucket from the excavator or plywood will be used to lessen the impact on the water dispersal
