**Re: Letter of Permission (LOP), for Maintenance of a Public Beach Viewing Site, Glynn County Owner Public Right-of-Way, St. Simons Island, Glynn County, Georgia

Dear Mr. Vicent:

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request, received October 1, 2018, to perform maintenance of a public beach viewing site at the Glynn County owned public Right-of-Way within the area formally known as Eighth Street. Maintenance of the public beach viewing area includes the trimming of existing landscaped shrubs and the reinstallation of a public viewing area sign. The shrubs will be trimmed down to approximately four feet from the ground with the use of hand tools, and all debris will be disposed of off-site at an appropriate location. A public viewing area sign will be installed at the previous sign location with hand tools. The sign will be 30 in. x 24 in. and six feet tall with post. This project will begin no sooner than 15 days from the date of this letter and must be completed no later than six (6) months from the date of this letter.

The Department authorizes the maintenance of the public beach viewing site as depicted in the attached description and drawings, provided all Best Management Practices (BMPs) should be used. **No unauthorized equipment, materials, or debris may be placed, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas.** Any incidental damage to dunes or dune vegetation will require restoration to be coordinated through this office. This LOP is valid for the above referenced project. Any change in the use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without prior notification and approval from this office could result in revocation of this permission and in the required removal of the related structures. This LOP does not relieve you from obtaining any other required federal, state, or local permits. 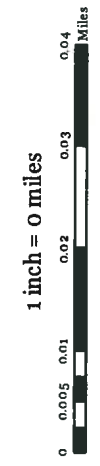
