Dear Mr. Collins:

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request, received January 8, 2019, for the reissuance of the LOP previously issued on July 31, 2018, for repairs and maintenance to the existing marine railway. Due to delays in construction, the activities authorized previously have not been conducted. The structure was originally authorized by the Department on April 19, 1979. The existing structure is 35ft. x 120ft. The maintenance would include sediment removal and repairs to timbers and pilings, as needed. Approximately 12 to 15 cubic yards of sediment will be removed with a mini excavator and tractor. The sediment will be removed from the site and disposed of at the Camden County landfill. The work is anticipated to be completed within one to two days. There will be no change to the current footprint of the railway. The repairs and maintenance will begin no sooner than 15 days from the date of this letter and will be completed no later than six (6) months from the date of this letter.

The Department authorizes the repairs and maintenance of the marine railway within Coastal Marshlands Protection Act jurisdiction, as depicted in the attached description and drawing, provided Best Management Practices (BMP's) are used as may be required in Glynn County. Debris and sediment must be disposed of at an appropriate upland area. **No unauthorized equipment, materials, or debris may be placed, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas.** Any incidental damage to coastal marshlands will require restoration to be coordinated through this office. This LOP is valid for the above referenced project. Any change in the use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without prior notification and approval from this office could result in revocation of this permission and in the required removal of the related structures.

Please find enclosed a fully executed revocable license for the above-described project. This license serves as authorization to utilize state owned tidal water bottoms for your project, as per the dimensions and configuration described. Any change in the use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without prior notification and approval from this office, could result in revocation of this license and in the required removal of the materials and related structures.

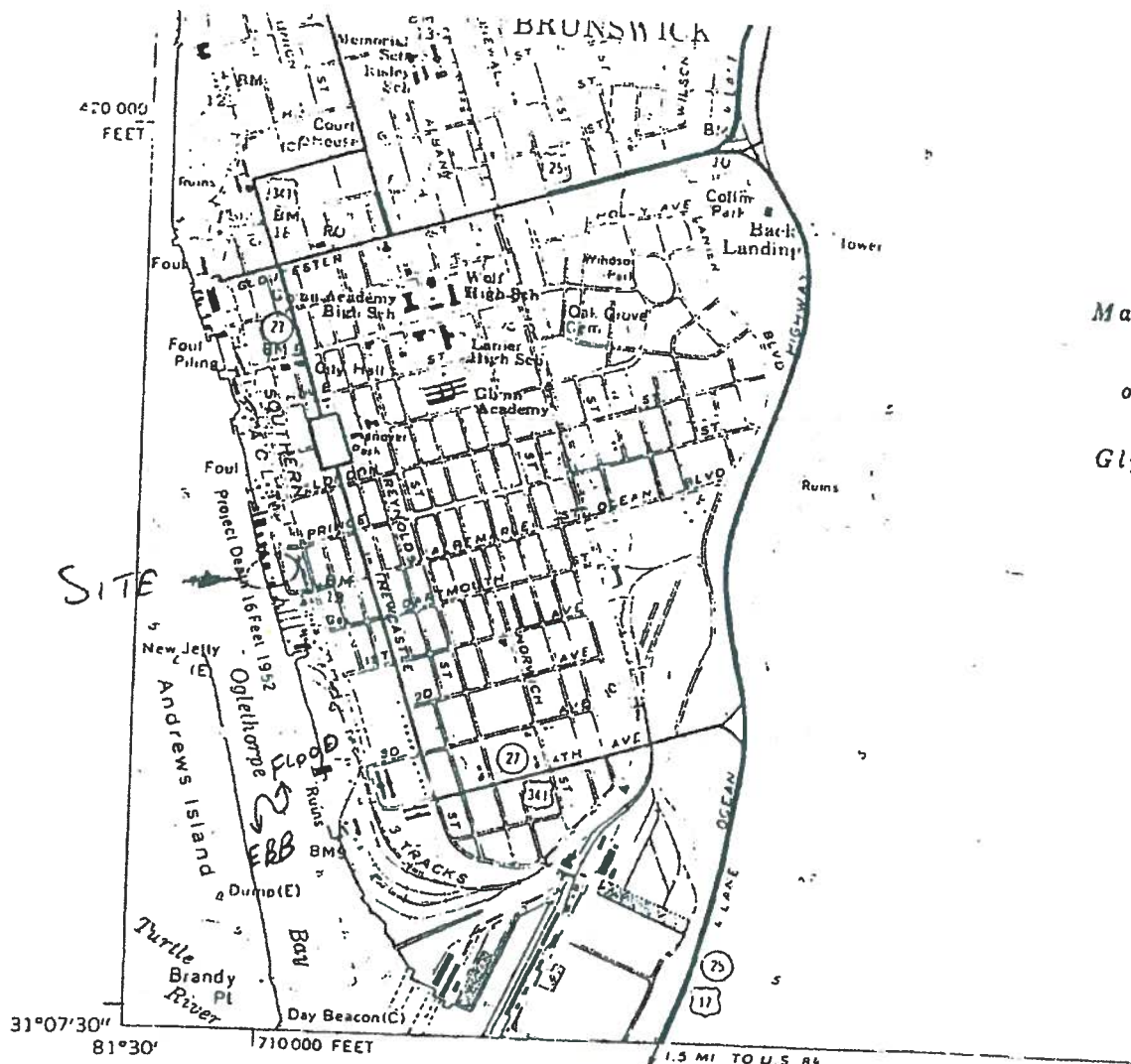

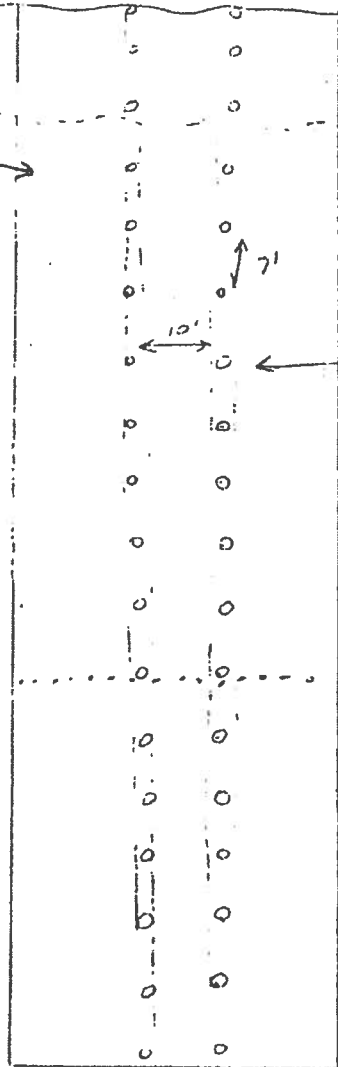
