Re: Letter of Permission (LOP) and Revocable License (RL) for the Repair of a Round Concrete Culvert, Georgia Episcopal Center Road, Honey Creek Marshes, Camden County, Georgia (GPS: 31.0518N, -81.5425W)

Dear Ms. McNamee,

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request, received December 22, 2020, on behalf of the Camden County Board of Commissioners, for the repair of a broken section of concrete culvert under Georgia Episcopal Center Road that is within jurisdiction of the Coastal Marshlands Protection Act (CMPA). The broken section of the culvert will be removed with a hydraulic excavator stationed on the upland and all materials will be staged on the shoulders of the road. Suitable gravel bedding will be placed under the existing footprint to support the reattached section to the culvert under the roadway. New riprap will be placed upland of CMPA jurisdiction to provide erosion protection once the culvert is repaired. There will be no change to the current footprint of the existing culverts. During the culvert repair a 140 lf. portion of a non-jurisdictional drainage ditch will be cleared just northeast of the culvert repair. The ditch maintenance activities do not require additional authorization. The project may begin at the issuance of this LOP and must be completed within six (6) months.

The Department authorizes the repair of the culvert within jurisdiction of the CMPA as described in the attached description and has no objection to the action. All debris must be disposed of at an appropriate upland location. No unauthorized equipment, materials or debris may be placed, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas.

Please find enclosed a fully executed Revocable License (RL) for the project described above. This license serves as an authorization to utilize state owned tidal water bottoms for your project. Any change in the use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without prior notification and approval from this office could result in revocation of this permission and in the required removal of the related structures.

This authorization does not relieve you from obtaining any other federal, state, or local permits. If you have any further questions or concerns regarding this or any other projects, please feel free to contact Paul Tobler at (912) 262-3134.
