Re: Letter of Permission (LOP), Film Production and Related Activities for <u>Summer Break</u>, Kimoyo II Productions LLC., Temporary Activities in the State's Coastal Marshlands Protection Act Jurisdiction, Mary Ross Waterfront Park, East River, Glynn County, Georgia (GPS Points: 31.14885° -81.49857°)

Dear Mr. Neal:

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request dated June 30, 2021, to film scenes for the above referenced production at Mary Ross Waterfront Park, Brunswick, Glynn County, Georgia. The proposed project includes the temporary use of production equipment and specified vessels within the State's Coastal Marshlands Protection Act (CMPA) jurisdiction at the Mary Ross Waterfront Park in Brunswick, Georgia. Filming within CMPA jurisdiction will begin no sooner than 15 days from the date of this letter and will be completed no later than November 30, 2021.

Filming & Rain Dates:

Proposed set-up will occur between October 23, 2021 and October 29, 2021. Proposed filming will occur between October 30, 2021, and November 2, 2021. All scenes will be filmed during evening and nighttime hours, 5:00pm to 7:00am, while set-up and strike may occur throughout the day. Breakdown will follow filming and be completed on November 4, 2021. These dates are subject to change due to work schedules and weather but will absolutely occur by November 30, 2021.

Filming Location

Filming will occur in the East River at Mary Ross Waterfront Park, located between points 31.15010, -81.50032 and 31.14706, -81.49894, and between which points public access and marine traffic will be controlled by law enforcement during filming. A detailed location of the film and staging location can be found in the attached map.

Public Access

Public access will be temporarily halted on the East River at Mary Ross Waterfront Park between points 31.15010, -81.50032 and 31.14706, -81.49894. Law enforcement will be on-site to maintain a safety zone and re-direct any other marine traffic for the duration of filming.

General Provisions:

- Crew, vehicles, and/or equipment may not enter the vegetated marsh.
- The Department will inspect all areas as described above during and at the termination of the temporary activities to ensure that those areas are in a condition consistent with the authorization granted by this LOP. No jurisdictional vegetation is to be disturbed during approved activities. Any incidental impacts to the vegetation must be restored to preactivity vegetated and topographic conditions as determined by the Department.
- At the end of production, all equipment and debris will be removed, and the marsh will be restored to its pre-activity condition.
- Although public access may be temporarily restricted, all efforts shall be made to allow reasonable public access at and around the filming location.
- No unauthorized equipment may be stored in jurisdiction.

The Department authorizes the filming as depicted in the attached description provided best management practices are used. The Department may inspect all areas as described above during and at the termination of the temporary activities to ensure that those areas are in a condition consistent with the authorization granted by this LOP. No jurisdictional vegetation is to be disturbed during approved activities. **No unauthorized equipment, materials, or debris may be**

placed, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas. Any incidental damage or impacts associated with this project must be rectified by fully restoring areas to their pre-construction topographic and vegetative state as determined by the Department. This LOP is valid for the above referenced project. Any change in the date, use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without prior notification and approval from this office could result in revocation of this permission and in the required removal of the materials and related structures. This project must comply with all other Federal, State, and local statutes, ordinances and regulations.
