Dear Mr. Brown:

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is a reissuance of LOP20240012 to maintain an existing permitted facility operated by Savannah Bar Pilots, Inc. located on the Savannah River. The scope of work authorized February 22, 2024 has not changed. The existing dock was originally authorized September 23, 1973 by the US Army Corps of Engineers. The project will begin no sooner than fifteen (15) days from the date of this letter and be completed within six (6) months.

The project consists of installation of one H-pile adjacent to a fractured concrete pile and replacement of 30 upper and lower cross timbers on the outside of the existing structure. No additional work is proposed.

The Department authorizes the maintenance of the dock facility in the current footprint as depicted in the attached description and drawings. No unauthorized equipment, materials, or debris may be placed in, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas. All material removed must be disposed of at an appropriate upland disposal area. Any visible alterations in marsh topography will be restored immediately using low-impact hand tools. Any damage to the marsh vegetation that has not recovered naturally during the next growing season will be repaired by a method acceptable to the Department.

Please find enclosed a fully executed Revocable License (RL) for the project described above. This license serves as an authorization to utilize state owned tidal water bottoms for your project. Any change in the use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without prior notification and approval from this office could result in revocation of this permission and in the required removal of the related structures.

This authorization does not relieve you from obtaining any other required federal, state, or local permits. Tidal water bottoms and marshlands of coastal Georgia are public trust lands controlled by the State, except for such lands where a validated Crown Grant or State Grant exists.

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request to maintain an existing permitted facility operated by Savannah Bar Pilots, Inc. located on the Savannah River. The existing dock was authorized September 23, 1973 by the US Army Corps of Engineers. The project will begin no sooner than fifteen (15) days from the receipt of this letter and be completed no later than six (6) months after the date of this letter.

The proposed project has been modified since its original submission and currently consists of the installation of one H-pile adjacent to a fractured concrete pile and replacement of 30 upper and lower cross timbers on the outside of the existing structure. No additional work is proposed.

The Department authorizes the maintenance of the dock facility in the current footprint as depicted in the attached description and drawings. No unauthorized equipment, materials, or debris may be placed in, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas. All material removed must be disposed of at an appropriate upland disposal area. The Revocable License authorizes use of lands presumed to be owned by the State of Georgia, and which are under control of the State. This Revocable License is issued with the understanding and condition that it could be rendered invalid should another person demonstrate ownership to such lands pursuant to a valid Crown Grant or State Grant. 






Photo 4: Example of lower cross timber to be replaced

Congress approved March 3, 1899 (33 U.S.C. 403), entitled "An act making appropriations for the construction, repair, and preservation of certain public works on rivers and harbors, and for other purposes," you are hereby authorized by the Secretary of the Army to the Army (222') and the Secretary of the Army

in accordance with the plans and drawings attached hereto (2 dames)

subject to the following conditions:

- (a) That this instrument does not convey any property rights either in real estate or material, or any exclusive privileges; and that it does not authorize any injury to private property or invasion of private rights, or any infringement of Federal, State or local laws or regulations, nor does it obviate the necessity of obtaining State or local assent required by law for the structure or work authorized.
- (b) That the structure or work authorized herein shall be in accordance with the plans and drawings attached hereto and construction shall be subject to the supervision and approval of the District Engineer, Corps of Engineers, in charge of the District in which the work is to be performed.

(c) That the District Engineer may at any time make such inspections as he may deem necessary to assure that the construction or work is performed in accordance with the conditions of this permit and all expenses thereof shall

be borne by the permittee.

(d) That the permittee shall comply promptly with any lawful regulations, conditions, or instructions affecting the structure or work authorized herein if and when issued by the Environmental Protection Agency and/or the State water pollution control agency having jurisdiction to abate or prevent water pollution, including thermal or radiation pollution. Such regulations, conditions or instructions in effect or hereafter prescribed by the Environmental Protection Agency and/or the State agency are hereby made a condition of this permit.

(e) That the permittee will maintain the work authorized herein in good

condition in accordance with the approved plans.

- (f) That this permit may, prior to the completion of the structure or work authorized herein, be suspended by authority of the Secretary of the Army if it is determined that suspension is in the public interest.⁸
- (g) That this permit may at any time be modified by authority of the Secretary of the Army if it is determined that, under existing circumstances, modification is in the public interest.* The permittee, upon receipt of a notice of modification, shall comply therewith as directed by the Secretary of the Army or his authorized representative.

(h) That this permit may be revoked by authority of the Secretary of the Army if the permittee fails to comply with any of its provisions or if the Secretary determines that, under the existing circumstances, such action is

required in the public interest.*

(i) That any modification, suspension or revocation of this permit shall

not be the basis for a claim for damages against the United States.

(j) That the United States shall in no way be liable for any damage to any structure or work authorized herein which may be caused by or result from future operations undertaken by the Government in the public interest.

(k) That no attempt shall be made by the permittee to forbid the full and free use by the public of all navigable waters at or adjacent to the structure

or work authorized by this permit.

(1) That if the display of lights and signals on any structure or work authorized herein is not otherwise provided for by law, such lights and signals as may be prescribed by the United States Coast Guard shall be installed and maintained by and at the expense of the permittee.

(m) That the permittee shall notify the District Engineer at what time the construction or work will be commenced, as far in advance of the time of commencement as the District Engineer may specify, and of its completion.








Photo 2: Location for H pile installation next to fractured pile
