Re: Letter of Permission (LOP), Placement of a Fireworks Display, Vicinity of King and Prince Resort, 201 Arnold Road, St. Simons Island, Atlantic Ocean, Glynn County, Georgia, (GPS 31.13915°N/-81.37815°W)

Dear Munnerlyn Pyrotechnics:

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request, dated April 18, 2025, to set up equipment for a Fireworks Display on the beach at The King and Prince Beach and Golf Resort, within Shore Protection Act (SPA) jurisdiction on June 21, 2025.

To accomplish the set-up, a flatbed trailer will be hauled onto the beach with a one ton 4-wheel drive pick-up truck. The flatbed trailer will serve as the firework launch site and will be located at one of the three locations depicted in the attached description and site maps dependent on tide and wind. All event activities will take place landward of the Ordinary High-Water Mark and seaward of the dunes.

During the fireworks display, local fire and emergency response vehicles will be parked within 100 yards of the shoot site location. A second pickup truck will also be parked near the flatbed trailer to run staff and supplies to and from the launch site. The equipment and vehicles will travel to the launch site via the DNR approved vehicle access points located at the Coast Guard Beach and Massengale Park.

To secure a 145ft. safety zone, a fence consisting of red metal posts driven into the sand and caution tape strung from post to post will be temporarily installed around the launch site. Directional signage will be tied directly to the fence posts and used in conjunction with Munnerlyn Pyrotechnics staff to prevent pedestrians from entering the safety zone.

Munnerlyn Pyrotechnics staff will begin set up on the afternoon of June 21, 2025, and position the flatbed trailer above the wrack line and seaward of the sand dunes. Removal will take place immediately following the event. All materials, equipment, litter, and debris will be removed. In the event of rain or other unforeseen events, set up and removal will occur between June 21, 2025 and June 22, 2025. No dunes or dune vegetation will be disturbed during the transport or set up of any of the structures.

As these activities will occur between May 1<sup>st</sup> and October 31<sup>st</sup>, sea turtle nesting season, an individual with a DNR Sea Turtle Cooperators Permit must survey the area prior to the work beginning. All sea turtle nests must be avoided, and no activity may occur within 20ft. of a sea turtle nest. No artificial light sources will be used for this event.

The Department authorizes the placement of the fireworks set up equipment as depicted in the attached description and site map and has no objection to the action. No unauthorized equipment, materials or debris may be placed, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas. Any incidental damage to dunes or dune vegetation will require restoration to be coordinated through this office. This LOP is valid for the above referenced project. Any change in the use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without prior notification and approval from this office could result in revocation of this permission and in the required removal of the related structures.

This LOP does not relieve you from obtaining any other federal, state, or local permits. If you have any further questions or concerns regarding this or any other projects, please feel free to contact Beth Byrnes at (912) 266-0277.

To Whom it May Concern,

Munnerlyn Pyrotechnics would like to request permission and use of the beach located at The King & Prince Beach & Golf Resort 201 Arnold Rd., St. Simons Island GA for a fireworks display scheduled on 6/21/2025. The event will feature a professionally coordinated firework show conducted by Munnerlyn Pyrotechnics and its licensed pyrotechnicians. We will ensure that all necessary safety precautions are in place, including a designated safety perimeter, crowd control, and post-event cleanup. The display will follow all local regulations, and we are prepared to collaborate with local law enforcement and fire departments to ensure public safety.

- 1. Site Setup: Identify and prepare designated launch zones, spectator areas, and safety perimeters. See Site Map Attached
- 2. Pyrotechnics Setup: Arrange and secure fireworks at launch sites following fire safety regulations.
- 3. Safety Inspections: Perform pre-show inspections of launch equipment, fire extinguishers, and emergency response measures.
- 4. Launch Coordination: Manage the timing of fireworks display sequences.
- 5. Crowd Management: Ensure proper signage, barriers, and personnel to guide spectators and control entry.
- Post-Display Clean-Up: Remove fireworks debris and perform a safety check of the site.

# Fireworks Setup and Launch

## King & Prince Beach Resort

Date: 4/16/2025

-Time: Setup from 2:00 PM to 8:00 PM, fireworks launch Approx. 9:00 PM - 9:30pm

- Munnerlyn Pyrotechnics will need to haul a flatbed trailer onto the beach which staff will utilize as a platform to launch this firework display. The trailer will be brought to the site in the early afternoon around 2pm on 6/21/25 via our approved access ramp which is located about 800-1,100 yards North of the launch site. The flatbed trailer will be primarily hauled to the site with a 1 ton 4 wd pickup truck.
- Trailer will be removed from the site in the same manner. The trailer will serve as the launch site and will be located approximately 100 yards Southeast of the King and Prince Beach Resort. Crews will only work on setting up the fireworks during daylight hours and no additional artificial light sources will be present on the beach at night. To secure a 145ft wide safety zone around the launch site, red medal posts will be driven into the sand with caution tape attached. The post and caution tape will be installed to prevent pedestrians from entering the safety zone. Additional temporary directional signage will be tied directly to the posts. In addition to the flatbed trailer, one pickup truck will be parked near the trailer to run staff and supplies to and from the launch site.
- -All guests in attendance to watch the fireworks display will be located at the King & Prince Beach Resort, or on the public beach that lies outside of the safety zone. Staff will patrol the entire event site to prevent guests from entering the shoot site and to safeguard any sea turtle nest sites. All event activities All event activities will take place landward of the ordinary of the high water mark and seaward of the dunes and there will be no disruption to the adjacent primary beach by vehicles or staff assembling the launch pad and site or during its removal at the conclusion of the event. Full completion of this scope of work will be installed and removed on the same day.
- -All fire trucks and other emergency vehicles will be parked nearby within 100 yards of the shoot site location (see site map), well away from any of the nearby dune habitats if any and well outside of the jurisdiction area.

-Activity Details: Licensed pyrotechnicians will place fireworks in pre-designated launch zones, ensuring proper setup (fireworks being used in this event will be a combination of 1.3 & 1.4 cakes – No Mortars.) A test fire will be conducted to ensure equipment functionality. The fireworks display will involve multiple aerial cakes.

-Safety Measures: A 145-foot perimeter will be established around the launch area. Fire extinguishers and emergency medical personnel will be on-site.



- (2) In addition to those days set forth in subsection 2-9-53(f)(1), consumer fireworks may also be used, ignited, or caused to be ignited on any other day after the time of 9:00 P.M. and up to and including the time of 11:59 P.M. if a permit for such use or ignition has been issued by the Glynn County Police Chief.

Munnerlyn Pyrotechnics, LLC will be responsible for removing any and all debris

from the site and performing a safety check of the site afterwards.

Review and Appeal

It is the specific intent of Glynn County to regulate only the time, place and manner of events and not to regulate the content or message of any speech or expressive conduct. Within fourteen (14) calendar days of the receipt of a fully completed, executed, and filed application, the Police Chief shall review the application in light of all of the contents thereof and the goals, intentions, and presumptions of this Ordinance as set out herein before, and render a decision and communicate same to Applicant, either permitting the event as planned or denying a permit for same. If the permit is denied, the Police Chief shall provide the Applicant in writing a statement of the reasons therefore.

Nothing in this process shall prevent the Police Chief, at his/her sole option and within the fourteen (14) calendar day period for approval or denial, to confer with Applicant with respect to modifications of Applicant's plan for the event, and amend the application to reflect such modifications if agreed to by applicant. However, applicant may neither supplement nor amend its application within said fourteen (14) calendar day period except at the invitation of the Police Chief. Any attempt to do so sua sponte shall be deemed a separate and new application.

The Police Chief may deny the application for permit upon any of the following reasons or combination of reasons:

1) The application does not contain all required information or materials, or the information set out in the application is so incomplete, vague, or ambiguous as to prevent full and proper review by the

2) The application contains material omissions, falsehoods, or misrepresentations;

3) The Applicant, or entity represented by Applicant, is incompetent to contract, sue, or be sued;

4) The person applying lacks authority to represent the entity for which the application is made;

5) The Applicant or entity represented by Applicant has on prior occasions damaged public property, or has not paid in full for such damages, or is in arrears as to any judgment civil, criminal, or administrative ruling rendered against the Applicant or entity, or is in violation of any injunction orestraining order entered against the Applicant or entity, whether under the same name or another;

6) The Applicant or entity represented by Applicant has on prior occasions violated permitting

ordinances in connection with events of a substantially similar, nature;

7) The plan of the event as proposed is likely to present a danger to the health or safety of participants in the event or other members of the public (though not through the agency of any predicted reaction by onlookers or members of the public);

8) The plan of the event as proposed is likely to restrict and/or congest traffic (vehicular or pedestrian) on any of the public roads, right of ways, sidewalks, or waterways in the immediate vicinity of

such event;

9) The plan of the event as proposed is likely to cause a disturbance of the peace; or is likely to burden lawful commerce in the area at the time of the proposed event, or is likely to intrude upon the privacy or property of citizens in the area of the proposed event; The plan of the event as proposed includes activities which are prohibited by laws of the United States, the State of Georgia, or ordinances of Glynn County, or activities which constitute nuisance or tortious conduct with respect to public or private property or persons; The plan of the event as proposed would conflict with previously planned programs or events organized and conducted by Glynn County and previously scheduled for the same time and place; The plan of the event as proposed is prohibited by or is inconsistent with the classifications and uses of the proposed or desired location; or A fully executed prior application for permit has been or will be granted to a prior Applicant authorizing uses or activities which do not reasonably permit multiple occupancy of that particular space. The plan of the event as proposed includes the use of sign(s), display(s), post(s), or placard(s), banner(s) which exceed 2'x3' in size, are made of a material other than paper, cardboard, poster board, or foam, are attached or affixed to any wooden, plastic, metal, or other type of support, or are draped or affixed to any Glynn County property, including, but limited to, the ground, trees, and buildings within Glynn County.

For events that have been granted a permit or events that do not require a permit, the Glynn County Police Department shall have the authority to terminate an event at any time, or prevent its initiation, should traffic, weather, or other conditions develop which present an imminent danger to those participating in the event or to the public at large. If an event is permitted and is terminated pursuant to this subsection, the permit shall be revoked for that day only. The Glynn County Police Department shall have the authority to terminate the event at any time or prevent its initiation should any consideration or combination of considerations enumerated herein as a ground for denial of a permit arise or first become apparent to the Glynn County Police Department after the grant of a permit. If an event is terminated pursuant to this subsection, the permit shall be permanently revoked.

If in preparation for or after the start of an event for which a permit has been issued, participants in said event violate the terms of the permit or deviate in material fashion from the plan submitted in the application for the permit, the Glynn County Police Department shall have the authority to terminate the event at any time or prevent its initiation. If an event is terminated pursuant to this subsection, the permit shall be permanently revoked.

The event will feature a professionally coordinated firework show conducted by Munnerlyn Pyrotechnics and its licensed pyrotechnicians. We will ensure that all necessary safety precautions are in place, including a designated safety perimeter, crowd control, and post-event cleanup. The display will follow all local regulations, and we are prepared to collaborate with local law enforcement and fire departments to ensure public safety.

- 1. Site Setup: Identify and prepare designated launch zones, spectator areas, and safety perimeters. See Site Map Attached

- -Time: Setup from 2:00 PM to 8:00 PM, fireworks launch Approx. 9:00 PM 9:30pm
- Munnerlyn Pyrotechnics will need to haul a flatbed trailer onto the beach which staff will utilize as a platform to launch this firework display. The trailer will be brought to the site in the early afternoon around 2pm on 6/21/25 via our approved access ramp which is located about 800-1,100 yards North of the launch site. The flatbed trailer will be primarily hauled to the site with a 1 ton 4 wd pickup truck.
- Trailer will be removed from the site in the same manner. The trailer will serve as the launch site and will be located approximately 100 yards Southeast of the King and Prince Beach Resort. Crews will only work on setting up the fireworks during daylight hours and no additional artificial light sources will be present on the beach at night. To secure a 145ft wide safety zone around the launch site, red medal posts will be driven into the sand with caution tape attached. The post and caution tape will be installed to prevent pedestrians from entering the safety zone. Additional temporary directional signage will be tied directly to the posts. In addition to the flatbed trailer, one pickup truck will be parked near the trailer to run staff and supplies to and from the launch site.
- -All guests in attendance to watch the fireworks display will be located at the King & Prince Beach Resort, or on the public beach that lies outside of the safety zone. Staff will patrol the entire event site to prevent guests from entering the shoot site and to safeguard any sea turtle nest sites. All event activities All event activities will take place landward of the ordinary of the high water mark and seaward of the dunes and there will be no disruption to the adjacent primary beach by vehicles or staff assembling the launch pad and site or during its removal at the conclusion of the event. Full completion of this scope of work will be installed and removed on the same day.
- -All fire trucks and other emergency vehicles will be parked nearby within 100 yards of the shoot site location (see site map), well away from any of the nearby dune habitats if any and well outside of the jurisdiction area.

-Activity Details: Licensed pyrotechnicians will place fireworks in pre-designated launch zones, ensuring proper setup (fireworks being used in this event will be a combination of 1.3 & 1.4 cakes – No Mortars.) A test fire will be conducted to ensure equipment functionality. The fireworks display will involve multiple aerial cakes.

-Safety Measures: A 145-foot perimeter will be established around the launch area. Fire extinguishers and emergency medical personnel will be on-site.


