If water quality certification is required, send only application, location map and drawing to address No. 4.

For Revocable License State of Georgia (six coastal counties plus Effingham, Long, Wayne, Brantley and Charlton counties only) Request must have State of Georgia's assent or a waiver authorizing the use of State owned lands. All applications for dock permits in the coastal counties or for docks located in tidally influenced waters in the counties listed above need to be submitted to Real Estate Unit. In addition to instructions above, you must send two signed form letters regarding revocable license agreement to: Ecological Services Coastal Resources Division, Georgia Department of Natural Resources, 1 Conservation Way, Brunswick, Georgia 31523. Describe the proposed activity, its purpose and intended use, including a description of the type of structures, if any to be erected on fills, piles, of float-supported platforms, and the type, composition and quantity of materials to be discharged or dumped and means of conveyance. The proposed project consists of maintenance and modifications to an existing wooden dock structure, which consists of a fixed wooden and floating dock, and seeks documentation for two boat ramps so that those may remain in place. Maintenance and modifications include the addition of a 13'-11" by 5'-6" eastern access point, a 12' x 15' x 12'-1 1/2" pavilion roof, and replacement of boards using 7'-0 3/4" planks. All modifications were conducted on the existing fixed wooden dock structure, and the floating dock and boat ramps remained untouched. The intent of the maintenance and modification to the wooden dock structure is to make a safe structure for use in conjunction with the adjoining commercial facility (i.e. wedding venue).

The previous landowners permitted a portion of the dock on 12 December 1985, and then between 1993 and 1999 the dock underwent an unauthorized modification to construct the supporting structure that stands there today. The construction plans and techniques are unknown to the applicant. The maintenance and modification completed by the current landowner in 2021 was performed with hand tools only. As a result, compensatory mitigation should not be required for the actions.

- 17. Water Quality Certification: In some cases, Federal law requires that a Water Quality Certification from the State of Georgia be obtained prior to issuance of a Federal license or permit. - 5. Plan and profile drawings showing limits of areas to be dredged, areas to be used for placement of spoil, locations of any dikes to be constructed showing locations of any weir(s), and typical cross sections of the dikes.
 - b. Please provide the following statements:
 - 1. A statement that all activities will be performed in a manner to minimize turbidity in the stream.

 All activities related to the current landowners modifications were performed in a manner that minimized turbidity to the stream.
 - 2. A statement that there will be no oils or other pollutants released from the proposed activities which will reach the stream. No oils or other pollutants were released from the activities performed.
- 3. A statement that all work performed during construction will be done in a manner to prevent interference with any legitimate water uses.

 All work performed during construction was completed in a manner that did not interfere with any legitimate water uses.
- 18. Application is hereby made for a permit or permits to authorize the activities described herein; Water Quality Certification from the Georgia Environmental Protection Division is also requested if needed. I certify that I am familiar with the information contained in this application, and that to the best of my knowledge and belief such information is true, complete and accurate.
