Dock Narrative

To whom it may concern,

The below provides information regarding the Bethesda Dock Association's request for an additional dock, located at 9520 Ferguson Avenue in Savannah, GA.

- **Existing/Proposed**
 - The Bethesda Home for Boys campus at 9520 Ferguson Avenue, Savannah, GA borders Moon River and has an existing facility for water access, however it is unserviceable. The applicant proposes a low-impact, pile supported recreational dock structure, which includes a walkway, fixed deck, ramp, and floating dock.

- **Marshland Component**
 - Walkway – 6' x 8' (48 SF) timber walkway extending from the upland bank to the fixed deck, elevated on driven timber piles to clear all marsh vegetation and maintain tidal flow.
 - A fixed deck, 15' x 20' (300 SF) covered deck with an 18-inch eaves and roof height $\leq 12'$.
 - Ramp and Floating Dock – A 3' x 24' aluminum gangway will connect the deck to a 10' x 20' (200 SF) pile-supported floating dock, which will remain off-bottom at low tide. The entire structure projects ≤ 27 ft seaward of mean low water, well inside the CMPA 40-ft $\frac{1}{4}$ -channel limit.
 - Navigation clearance – There are no adjacent docks within 1,290 ft south or 3,263 ft north, avoiding interference with neighboring access routes.

- **Upland Component and 50ft. buffer if applicable**
 - There is no upland component to this proposed dock structure.
