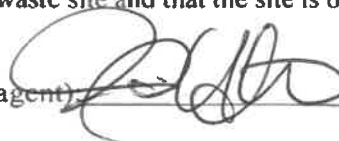

A CONVEYANCE, made as of this March 31, 1999, from ALFRED W. JONES, III, ANN JONES GREGG, JAMES McDONALD JONES, MARGARET JONES GARNER, MELANIE ELIZABETH JONES CRANFORD, CHARLES EDWARD KUNTZ, KATHARINE KUNTZ REVELS, JUDITH KUNTZ BYRNE, DAVID L. KUNTZ, JR., ELIZABETH ANN O'CONNOR MILLIGAN, MARIANNA T. MENKOL, KATHARINE O'CONNOR GIERY, and SARAH O'CONNOR STEENROD, as the First Parties, to GLYNN COUNTY, GEORGIA, as the Second Party,

WITNESSETH:

1. Alfred W. Jones, Sr., died on June 9, 1982, leaving a will and three codicils thereto which were probated in solemn form and admitted to record as his last will and testament in the Probate Court of Glynn County, Georgia, on June 22, 1982. Alfred W. Jones, Jr. qualified as Executor, administered the estate and was issued Letters of Dismission by said Court on June 5, 1989.

2. In 1999, Alfred W. Jones, Jr., learned that at the time of his death, Alfred W. Jones, Sr., held title to the real property hereinafter described. The estate was reopened on March 31, 1999, and Alfred W. Jones, Jr., was re-appointed as Executor of the Estate of Alfred W. Jones, Sr.

3. Under the last will and testament of Alfred W. Jones, Sr., the real property hereinafter described would have been allocated to the marital trust created for the benefit of Katharine T. Jones in Item VI under the will of Alfred W. Jones, Sr.

4. Katharine T. Jones died on October 14, 1986, leaving a will and two codicils thereto which were probated in solemn form and admitted to record as her last will and testament in the Probate Court of Glynn County, Georgia. Alfred W. Jones, Jr., qualified as Executor and administered the estate.

5. Under the will of Alfred W. Jones, Sr., Katharine T. Jones was granted a power of appointment under the marital trust. In Item VI of her will, Katharine T. Jones exercised said power of appointment and appointed all of the property of that trust to First Parties herein who are the grandchildren of Katharine T. Jones who survived her.

6. The First Parties seek herein to ratify the conveyance of the within described property by A. W. Jones, Jr., as Executor of the Last Will and Testament of A. W. Jones, Sr., to Second Party, dated March 31, 1999, and recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Glynn County Superior Court at Deed Book 567, page 001.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto give, convey and assign unto the Second Party, its legal representatives, successors and assigns, the following described real property, to-wit:

All of that certain lot, tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being on the Island of St. Simons, in Glynn County, Georgia, which is more particularly described and identified according to that certain plat of survey by Gary R. Nevill, Georgia Registered Surveyor No. 2401, dated February 23, 1998, a copy of which is now or shortly to be recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Glynn County, Georgia, as follows: to locate the beginning point, commence at the point which marks the northeast corner of Ocean Boulevard and Olive Way, according to said plat which is the point of intersection of the southeasterly right-of-way line of Ocean Boulevard with the northeasterly right-of-way line of Olive Way, and from said point running thence south 42 degrees 14 minutes 14 seconds west for a distance of 1,474.25 feet to the point or place of beginning; thence proceed south 49 degrees 15 minutes 00 seconds east for a distance of 895.98 feet to a point; thence south 47 degrees 37 minutes 18 seconds west for a distance of 16.05 feet to a point; thence north 50 degrees 07 minutes 01 seconds west for a distance of 895.04 feet to a point on the said right-of-way of Ocean Boulevard north 42 degrees 27 minutes 10 seconds east for a distance of 29.49 feet to the point or place of beginning, which lot contains 0.466 acres, according to said plat.

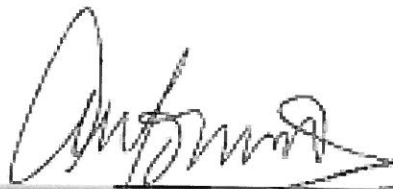
