All applications for dock permits in the coastal counties, or for docks located in tidally influenced waters in the counties listed above need to be submitted to Real Estate Unit. Permission from Adjoining Highland Owner to Carry Out a Coastal Marshlands Protection Act of 1970, as amended, Permitted Project, as Required by Official Code of Georgia Annotated Section 12-5-286(b)(4).

I, Melissa Memory, in my capacity as the Superintendent of Fort Pulaski National Monument, having a street address of 41 Cockspur Island Road, Savannah GA 31401, do on behalf of National Park Service, as owner of Parcel 10022-01001 located on Cockspur Island in Chatham County, Georgia, have lawful authority to use certain real property lying and situate within Unincorporated Chatham County, 5th G.M.D., and hereby give permission to the United States Coast Guard (USCG) to use the inter-tidal area or adjoining marshland and/or tidal water bottoms for the purpose of construction, operation, and use to access the Savannah River as described in the application for a Coastal Marshlands Protection Committee Permit dated April 20, 2023 as submitted by USCG. The proposed project includes replacement of a boat ramp and construction of a new launch and recovery dock on property owned by National Park Service. The site is located at Lat. 32.03406', Long -80.90371'. Once completed, this boat ramp will be used for administrative use only by the USCG and the NPS.

I am familiar with the permit application and the proposed activity which includes the improvements to the existing boat ramp at coordinates Lat. 32.03406', Long. -80.90371. The improvements encroach into the waterfront of National Park Service property, and I hereby give permission to USCG, whose mailing address for the purpose of the permit application is: 11 Cockspur Island Road, Attention; Capt. J.D. Berry, to use the inter-tidal area adjacent to the real property described on the attached deed, to use the property, as may be necessary and proper to carry out the proposed project. I understand that carrying out the project and related activities in and over marshland and inter-tidal water bottoms contiguous to land I have lawful authority to use and give permission to USCG to use the owner's land to carry out the proposed project. I understand that carrying out the project and related activities encroaches upon marshland and tidal water bottoms contiguous to the land I have lawful authority to use requires a Coastal Marshlands Protection Act of 1970, as amended, permit. I understand the Applicant for a permit proposes a project that the law requires permission from the adjoining landowner to complete the application process. I understand that this permission does not create any contract rights, and is consistent with the terms of the 2020 Interagency Agreement between the USCG and the NPS, and I understand that the proposed activity is subject to change or the site may be deleted as a project location either by the Applicant, or as a result of the Committee's actions.
