All applications for dock permits in the coastal counties, or for docks located in tidally influenced waters in the counties listed above need to be submitted to Real Estate Unit. Bulkhead will closely follow the existing marsh/upland boundary to minimize fill area. Total fill below the High tide line is  $\pm -8.47$  cubic vards, or 0.077 cubic vards per running foot. In accordance with U.S. Army Corps of Engineers regulations compensatory mitigation is not required for loss of waters of the U.S. that area less than one-tenth (0.10) acre.

WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION: In some cases. Federal law requires that a Water Quality Certification from thate or Georgia be obtained prior to issuance of a Federal license or permit.
