**912.644.5217****Health Department Issues Advisory for St. Andrews Beach**

**GLYNN COUNTY, GA**— St. Andrews Beach (from Macy Lane to St. Andrews picnic area) has been placed under advisory by the Glynn County Health Department.

Routine water quality tests from samples taken January 11 show the beach water at St. Andrews Beach contains a high level of enterococci bacteria, which increase the risk of gastrointestinal illness in swimmers.

The Glynn County Health Department recommends you do not swim or wade in the water in the area under advisory. Fish and other seafood caught from this area should be thoroughly washed with fresh water and thoroughly cooked before eating.

The area will be retested and the advisory will be lifted when tests show the bacteria levels meet the Environmental Protection Agency's recommended standard.
