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**Beach Advisories Issued for Four Jekyll Island Beaches and Three St. Simons Beaches;  
Advisory for Massengale Park Beach on St. Simons Remains**

**GLYNN COUNTY, GA** – The Glynn County Health Department has issued the following advisories:

**Jekyll Island**

- Capt. Wylly Rd. Crossover Beach (Brice Lane to beach pavilion)
- Middle Beach at the Convention Center (beach pavilion to beach deck)
- South Dunes Picnic Area Beach (beach deck to south water tower)
- South Beach at 4H Camp (south water tower to Macy Lane)

**St. Simons Island**

- North Beach at Goulds Inlet (Fifteenth to Tenth Street)
- East Beach old Coast Guard Station (Tenth Street to Driftwood Drive)
- 5<sup>th</sup> Street Crossover Beach (Cedar Street to 9<sup>th</sup> Street)

In addition, Massengale Park Beach (Driftwood Drive to Cedar Street) on St. Simons Island remains under advisory.

These advisories are only for the areas specified above and do not impact any other beaches on the islands. The beach water advisories are to alert the public of a possible risk of illness associated with water contact but do not mean the beaches are closed.

The Glynn County Health Department recommends you do not swim or wade in the water in the areas under advisory. Fish and other seafood caught from these areas should be thoroughly washed with fresh water and thoroughly cooked before eating as should fish or seafood caught from any waters.

The areas will be retested and the advisories will be lifted when tests show the bacteria levels meet the Environmental Protection Agency's recommended standards.

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
